We are also in need of drivers to take seniors and adults with disabilities to medical appointments, dialysis, grocery shopping, the bank and more. We pay a per-kilometer rate to cover the cost of gas.

You can also choose your own hours and how much or how little you wish to drive and you decide where you want to drive e.g., just in town, only as far as a neighbouring community, or as far as Ottawa. You are the valued volunteer so you call the shots!
